

# 2020-2021 eLearning Plans

## Snow days vs. Covid-19 school closures *Family Guide*

The 2020-2021 school year is a year in which our families have to be prepared with two distinctly different eLearning plans to address two different situations:

- School cancellation due to inclement weather (snow days).
- School closures due to Covid-19.

In the event of school closure, due to inclement weather, the district will be following our normal district **eLearning plan** which addresses a temporary or one day closure.

The Covid-19 plan or **the continuous learning plan** addresses a prolonged closure in which NEW learning and typical day instructional activities are carried out. This plan is used when families choose eLearning, as well as in the event of a prolonged school closure due to Covid-19. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED FOR IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION AND ARE QUARANTINED.

Teacher hours	Teachers will be available for all students between the hours of 9:00-10:30 a.m. and 1:00-2:30 p.m..	Staff will be available during normal contracted hours and all lessons are posted by 8:00 a.m. for Middle School and High School and 9:00 a.m. for elementary school.
Due dates	High School and Middle School assignments will be due the same day they were assigned by 11:59 p.m. unless otherwise specified by a teacher. Elementary school students will have three school days following the eLearning day to turn in assignments.	Assignments will be due the same day they were assigned by 11:59 p.m.

\*In the event of a Covid Closure, families will be provided additional information on the learning plan.
