

A note to parents from the Hanover Business Office:

Textbook rental and general fees have been posted to your student's account and are due paid in full by January 31, 2020. Payments or partial payments are accepted online through your parent PowerSchool account portal at [www.hanover.k12.in.us](http://www.hanover.k12.in.us) or at your school office. Eligible fees will be referred to a credit agency for collection after January 31, 2020 and a \$10 collection fee will be added to your account. You may be eligible for state assistance with the textbook portion of your student's school fees if you qualify for Free and Reduced School Meals based on household size and income. A Meal and Textbook assistance application form is available at any school office or online. If your application is approved, your student will receive textbook assistance and free or reduced priced school meals. General or hands-on fees are the responsibility of the parent/guardian and are not eligible for the state waiver.

School bookkeepers will email account statements monthly to the email we have on file from PowerSchool. Please keep this email up to date and check your spam folder if you have not been receiving statements via email. Account balances for middle and high school students will change if classes are added or dropped. Charges are also added throughout the year and may include athletic transportation fees, Chromebook damage, textbook damage and lost library book fees.
