### **Frequently Asked Questions for the Hanover Kiddy Academy**

Number	Question	Answer
1.	Where is the Hanover Kiddy Academy located?	The new addition to the Hanover Central High School is next to the tennis courts. The HKA will have its own entrance and drive.
2	How can we sign our child up for the Hanover Kiddy Academy?	Registration was done in April. There are spaces remaining, but limited. Contact Lori Micic at 219-374-3501 for availability.
3	What days, options, and times, do we have for the Hanover Kiddy Academy	3 FULL DAY (Tues/ Wed/ Thurs) 8:30-2:30 3 HALF DAY (Tues/ Wed/ Thurs) from 8:30-11 AM or 12:00-2:30 PM.
4	Will my child's photo be posted online?	There will be a photo release form available at registration. Parents/ guardians can choose whether or not to allow the use of photos on district social media or websites.
5	How many students are in each class?	There will be 14 students in each class.
6	What happens if I am on the waiting list?	Families are assigned a number on the website. As openings occur, students will be offered a placement based on their number on the waiting list.
7	How much does the Hanover Kiddy Academy cost?	\$325 per month full day \$160 per month half-day
8	When is the monthly payment due?	Payment is due on the first of the month.
9	Are the fees different during months such as December when there is no school or a school break?	Yes, prorated fees will be shared with families each month based on the days in session.
10	How do you make payments for the Hanover Kiddy Academy?	TBD-
11	What does a typical day look like for the full-day program? half-day program?	A typical day will have a blend of whole and small group learning activities, purposeful play stations, and outdoor/gross motor activities for both the full-day and half-day programs. The full-day program will give the students extended opportunities in all areas.

<b>12</b>	Are snacks/ meals provided or will we need to provide a snack or meals for our child?	For the 2022-2023 school year, we are asking families to provide snacks and meals for their children.
<b>13</b>	Can parents volunteer?	Yes! Teachers will ask for volunteers when needed. Parents will need to complete background checks to be approved.
<b>14</b>	Does my child need immunizations and a school physical to start?	Yes. A physical will be required as well as immunizations. See the Pre-K requirements on the link below. <a href="https://www.hanover.k12.in.us/Page/3963">https://www.hanover.k12.in.us/Page/3963</a>
<b>15</b>	Are high school students teaching at the Hanover Kiddy Academy?	No, we have 2 licensed teachers that will be teaching the preschool students. High school students will be observing, interacting, and helping with students as part of their high school class.
<b>16</b>	How are high school students involved with this program?	High school students will be observing and interacting with the preschool students during their child development class period on preschool days. On non-preschool days, high school students will have their regular child development class.
<b>17</b>	Is there transportation?	No, Hanover will <b>not</b> be providing transportation. Families are responsible for transportation.
<b>18</b>	What is the approach to discipline?	Students will be taught rules and procedures for school that will help prepare them for kindergarten and continued success.
<b>19</b>	What is the teacher-to-student ratio?	Each classroom will have a licensed teacher and an aide for a 14:2 ratio.
<b>20</b>	If the corporation is closed due to a weather-related emergency, is the Hanover Kiddy Academy closed as well?	Yes, parents will be notified via social media, phone, and emails.
<b>21</b>	What are the teacher's qualifications at the Hanover Kiddy Academy?	Teachers have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in education.
