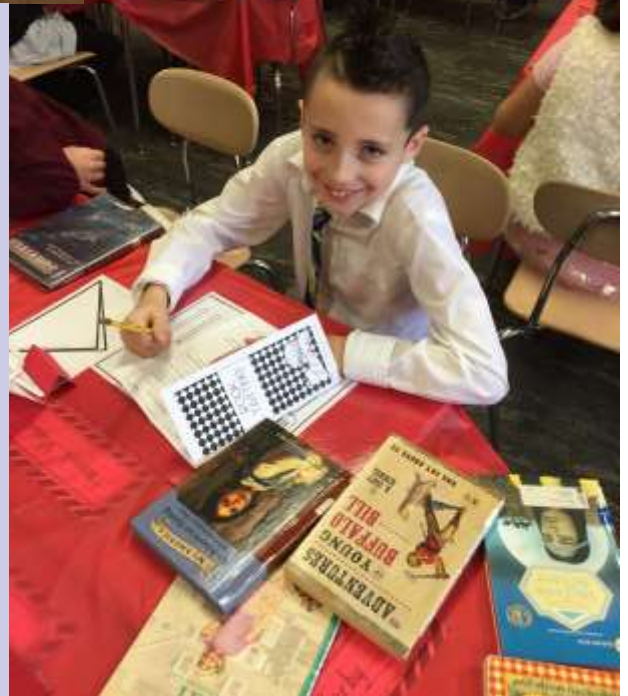
MAKING CHANGE
