- Class of 2019 T-Shirts- Pre-Ordering of shirts will begin TBD
- Cap & Gown Measurements- Monday, November 15, 2018. Pre-Orders for Cap & Gown will be on December 4 and 5, 2018. Cost- \$31
- Luncheon Cruise- Odyssey Cruises (Navy Pier) on Thursday, May 16, from 8:30 A.M.-3  :00 P.M. Cost- \$70 (includes luncheon and transportation) **1st deposit of \$35 is due by October 3, 2018, and full balance will be due by April 1, 2019. No refunds will be given after April 12, 2019. If you would prefer to pay in full by October 3, you may do so.
- Senior Class Trip- Six Flags Great America (Gurnee, IL) on Wednesday, May 22, 2019, from 8:30 A.M.- 6:00 P.M. Cost- \$60 (includes admission ticket, transportation, and 1 meal ticket)**1st deposit of \$30 is due by December 7, 2018, and the full balance is due by April 1, 2019. Again, no refunds will be given after April 12, 2019.

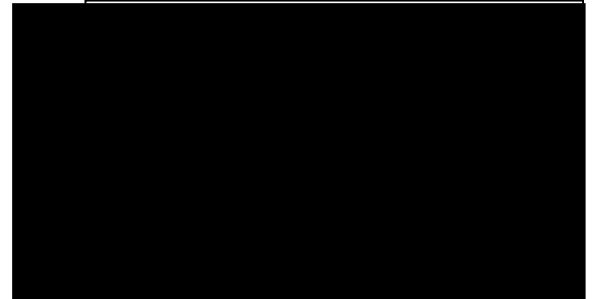
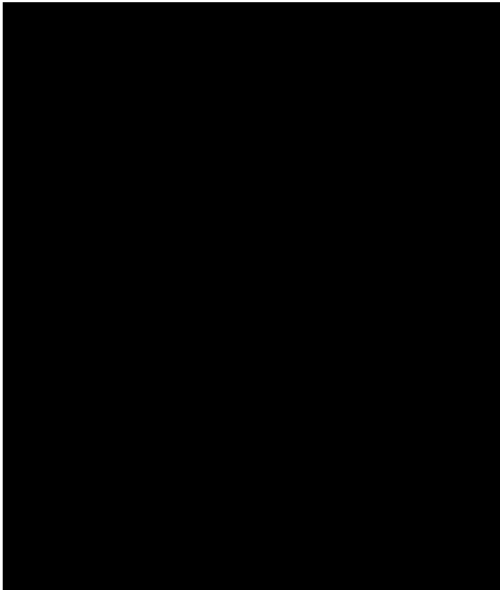

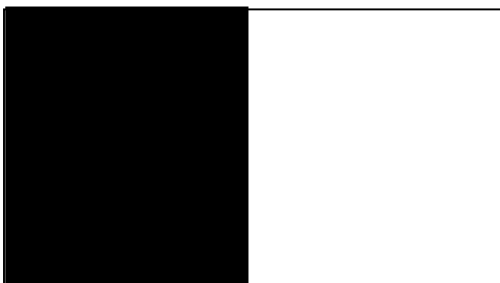

Dear Senior Parent:

Although it may seem as though your son or daughter just entered Hanover Central High School, graduation is right around the corner. The yearbook's annual fundraiser offers a creative way to show how proud you are of your graduating senior by publishing a senior ad in the yearbook. These ads may include a baby picture, current picture and a message to your son or daughter. For all ads, the picture(s) will be in color. Included is an order form containing prices and the information sheet. Please submit all ad materials together. Unfortunately, we cannot hold an ad space or process your order until we have all of your ad materials. All ads must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2019. Due to limited space, we will print ads on a first come first serve basis. The Key staff reserves the right to screen and edit all ads for content, appropriateness, spelling, grammar, and school policy compliance. We need to receive the original pictures in the best condition possible. Even though your pictures will be digitally scanned into the yearbook, avoid photos that are copied or printed from "picture-makers." However, you may wish to send a digital picture by submitting a CD with the photo(s) saved as a JPEG. Please avoid bending the photographs, as The Key will not be able to guarantee the final ad's quality. Please put your name and phone number on the back of each photo in pencil.

Guidelines when selecting photos:

- No cut-up photos. Photos from scrapbooks are sometimes trimmed into odd shapes. These may require you to use Photoshop to create backgrounds to set them in rectangular forms on the page. If parents submit oddly shaped photos that cannot be easily cropped, be sure to include an editing charge for adding the background to the photo.
- No photos with wallet boogers – you know, that sticky stuff that forms when photos have been carried around too long.
- Avoid blurry photos.
- Avoid over/underexposed photos.
- If too many photos are submitted, the yearbook staff will choose.
- Words should be typed – better yet, emailed! mduffy@hanover.k12.in.us
- Words will be edited if necessary.
- Grammar and spelling will be fixed.
- Editing will occur as needed.
