Hanover Schools plan to continue to meet the needs of the students upon their return to school. With Covid-19 still lingering, precautions are being taken to prevent the spread of the virus; this includes shutting down all the public drinking fountains. Students and staff have been asked to bring their own pre-filled water bottles to school. We know that there is going to continue to be a need for fresh drinking water throughout the day, so we are asking for your help again this year. Beginning August 2nd, we are asking the community, those who can, to donate cases of water to help us out. Water can be dropped off at any Hanover location from 9 am until 3 pm. We continue to thank you for all your support, and we are truly grateful for all the help we have been given.

Return to Learn Plan

The Hanover Community School Corporation will begin the 2021-2022 school year in the traditional manner with 100% in-person learning. Regarding Covid-19, efforts have been made to follow CDC guidelines, the Indiana Department of Health, the Indiana Department of Education, and our local Lake County Health Department. The following re-entry plan has been carefully considered to maintain the safety students and staff.

Masks will be **OPTIONAL** for both students and staff within the school setting and at outdoor events (including recess). However, masks are still **REQUIRED** when on the school bus. Social distancing of 3 feet is recommended in all areas of all buildings and seating charts in classrooms will be maintained as well. Assemblies and groups will occur with social distancing.

Cleaning of surfaces, tables, doors, and shared equipment will continue, as well as hand washing and hand sanitizer access in all classrooms and buses. Water fountains will remain closed for the 2021-2022 school year. Donations of bottled water will be gratefully accepted at all buildings.

Field trips will be approved by the building principal in cooperation with the superintendent to ensure safety of all students and staff. Volunteers will be allowed in the buildings, however, without proof of vaccination, they will be asked to wear a mask. Visitors are not allowed for the 2021-2022 school year. Extracurriculars recommend 3 feet of social distancing, optional mask wearing, and there will be no limits on seating.

If a student comes in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 and shows symptoms, that student **MUST** quarantine for 10 days following the onset of symptoms or if they have a **POSITIVE** test. If a student comes in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 and does **NOT** show symptoms, that student may return after day 8 **IF** they have a **NEGATIVE** test on days 5, 6 or 7. Students exempt from quarantine would be those who are vaccinated with documented proof and those have previously had Covid-19.

Transportation

Hanover Community School Corporation is focused on maintaining safe transportation for our students, especially during the pandemic. To keep our students and staff safe, masks are still REQUIRED when on the school bus, per the federal mandate. Seating charts on all buses will be also maintained, to ensure continuity and the safety of the students. We will continue to use Infofinder that allows you to see where your student(s) will be picked up and dropped off. If you cannot find your street through Infofinder, please call our transportation department at 374-3838.

Please ensure that your child understands the rules at the bus stop for safety.

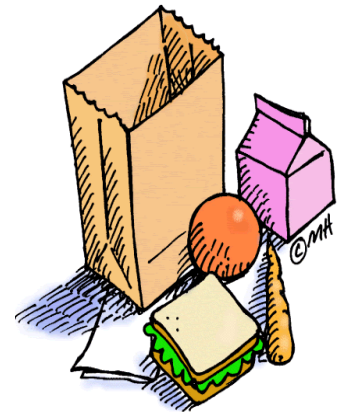
1. If on the opposite side of the street from the bus entrance, DO NOT cross until the driver gives the thumbs up before crossing to the door side of the bus.
2. Stand at least 20 ft. away from the roadway.
3. Single file line, to ensure the driver can see the students.
4. Wait for the PSSHHH sound of the parking brake before loading/ unloading.
5. Look both ways before crossing any street.

If something is dropped and goes under the bus, LEAVE IT. We can replace items, but our kids are irreplaceable!
