



Financial Assistance Available for Internet Access Costs

On May 12, 2021 families currently enrolled in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program may receive financial assistance to obtain free and/or reduced cost internet access.

The “Emergency Broadband Benefit” is a federal program that will end when the funds in the program are depleted. Families who need assistance should apply as soon as possible once the application program is opened on the 12th.
